This privacy notice specifically refers to our use of data collected in relation to the "Recalibrating Britain's Railways" hybrid event series (the "Event") hosted by Steer.

Purpose of the data collection

Data we need to collect and why

Data Security and Retention

Lawful basis for processing

We process your personal data on the lawful basis of our legitimate interests in marketing to our clients and potential clients, and in relation to providing the Event for the benefit of attendees. We will ask for your consent to be contacted by us in relation to future events and promotional activities.

Direct marketing

We may use your contact details to send you marketing materials, provided we are permitted to do so by law. You always have the right to unsubscribe from any marketing. You can do so by contacting us directly using the details below.

Who we share your data with and why

Microsoft Forms, which hosts the Event registration platform. Microsoft may send or host data outside the EEA. Microsoft has entered into the EU standard contractual clauses with Steer which requires them to provide similar protection to personal data, as we are required to provide under UK law. How long we will keep your data for?

Your rights as a data subject
